English - Spelling

We all, including children, need a range of spelling strategies to become proficient spellers...



Practical spelling activities to support a variety of learning styles

- ▶ Break words into syllables
- ▶ Identify root words
- ▶ Use or create mnemonic
- ▶ Sky writing
- ▶ Spellamadoodle
- ▶ Highlight the tricky bit
- ▶ Find words within words
- ▶ Exaggerate pronunciation
- ▶ Imagine word in mind
- ▶ Rhythmic recitation of spelling



Assessment



- ▶ No longer any levels
- ▶ Children will be assessed at either emerging, developing, being secure in or mastering the objectives for Year 3.
- ▶ Children have to meet all statutory objectives to be secure at the end of the academic year.
- ▶ Significantly raised expectations may mean it feels like your child's abilities have changed.
- ▶ Your child will receive these grades for all core subjects in their end of year report.
