Summary of PPF Spending in Academic Year 2017-18

Objectives in spending PPF:

- To ensure pupil premium children make good progress in relation to their prior attainment groups (PAGs) in maths, reading and writing.
- To specifically monitor writing at secure and above in both key stages, especially boys.
- To ensure pupil premium pupils in the Early Years make progress in line with their peers to gain a GLD
- To contribute to the good behaviour of pupil premium children where appropriate.
- To develop social, emotional and mental health for pupil premium children where appropriate.
- To improve attendance and punctuality for pupil premium children where appropriate.
- To offer support for the families of pupil premium children where appropriate.
- To provide speech and language therapists to improve children's comprehension, expression and speech.
- To provide all children with equal opportunities to access areas outside of the curriculum through extra-curricular clubs, activities and residential.
- To provide all children with equal opportunity to access music tuition.
- To provide all children with equal opportunity to access the school residential in Y6.
- To provide high quality 1-1 or group sessions led by experienced teacher and TA.

Summary of spending:

- Staff – PP Champion teaching 2.5 days, HLTA for literacy and numeracy, Learning Mentor (£60,337)
- Interventions – TA's running interventions every pm – September 2017 25/80children receiving intervention are PP
- 4 children supported to access the residential trip in Year 6 + extracurricular/day trips (£7500)
- Booster sessions (£14185)
- Gifted and talented tutor for more able PP pupils (£5000)
- Talking together – Early intervention for EYFS (£4000)
- Resources/ Forest school (£1000)
- Staff training to lead Forest School sessions, including PP Champion (£3600)
