Summary of PPF Spending in Academic Year 2014-15

Objectives in spending PPF:

- To accelerate progress of all children working below average in maths in Y2 & Y3
- To provide challenge for more able mathematicians
- All targeted children to achieve Level 4 in Maths and English at the end of KS2
- All targeted children to achieve Level 5 in Maths and English at the end of KS2
- All targeted children to attempt to achieve Level 6 in Maths and English at the end of KS2
- Targeted children who are behind end of KS2 target to achieve 2 levels of progress in KS2
- To accelerate the progress of children working below average in reading
- To provide all children with equal opportunities to access areas outside of the curriculum through extra-curricular clubs and activities
- To provide all children with equal opportunity to access music tuition
- To provide all children with equal opportunity to access the school residential in Y6

Summary of spending and actions taken:

- 3 TAs trained to deliver maths interventions (First Class Maths) to small groups of children. **£23473**
- Specialist maths teacher to deliver lessons to small group of children once a week **£1500**
- Staff CPD to deliver quality first teaching in English and Maths **£5950**
- Before school booster classes in Maths and English for target groups. **£12000**
- TAs and SENCO to deliver early reading interventions (SERI, Reading Recovery & BRP) **£34675**
- Speech Bubble **£10360**
- Clubs provided by outside agencies before and after school **£2915**
- Brass lessons funded by school 4 children **£464**
- Y6 residential funded by school for 11 pupils @ 300 = **£3300**.
- New mobile units for small hall providing areas for small group work **£5200**
- Educational Psychologist for PP child **£1300**
