- To provide speech and language therapists to improve children's comprehension, expression and speech.
- To provide all children with equal opportunities to access areas outside of the curriculum through extra-curricular clubs and activities
- To provide all children with equal opportunity to access music tuition
- To provide all children with equal opportunity to access the school residential in Y6

- To provide quiet and effective working space in addition to the classroom for small group work and interventions
